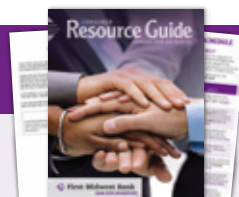




READINESS CHECKLIST.

Received

Become familiar with the transition to First Midwest.

DEBIT/ATM CARDS - See page 4 of the Consumer Resource Guide.

Received

Your new First Midwest Debit/ATM Card and PIN will arrive by mail by the end of January. You may continue to use your Standard Bank Debit/ATM Card until **May 17, 2017**.



Activated

Activate your new First Midwest Debit/ATM Card as soon as you receive it. Begin using it on February 6, 2017.

Important Tip

Prior to **February 3, 2017**, log into Standard Bank's Online Banking and save all transaction history and other information you deem important.



User ID

No action needed on your part. Your current Standard Bank Access ID and Password will remain the same and become your First Midwest Online Banking User ID and Password.

First Login

Agree to the Terms and Conditions, and to receive electronic disclosures. Then simply verify your identity. Just follow the prompts.

Bill Pay

No action needed on your part. Automated bill payments will continue as usual.

User ID/ Password

You can use your current Standard Bank Access ID and Password to access the First Midwest Bank Mobile App. You will need to step through our process to verify your identity.

Access

Standard Bank ATMs will be available during conversion weekend, but may not accept deposits between **January 23 - February 2, 2017**. Full access to over 55,000 surcharge-free First Midwest Bank and Allpoint™ begins on **February 6, 2017**.

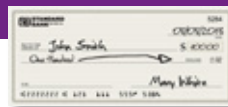

Standard Bank Touch-Tone Banking access ends at 6:00pm CST **February 3, 2017**. First Midwest Bank-Line access begins at 8:00am CST **February 6, 2017** at **800.322.3623**. Your PIN is the last 4 digits of the primary account holder's SSN.
